ServiceOntario has expanded its online renewal services with a virtual appointment service to renew photo (green) health cards.

A virtual appointment is a video call with a ServiceOntario customer service representative to help you renew your photo health card from home, without needing to visit a ServiceOntario centre.

Booking your appointment

A ServiceOntario customer service representative will:

- confirm you qualify and schedule your appointment
- 2. send you an email confirmation with your:
- appointment date and time
- a unique link to click and start your virtual appointment

The appointment

- The appointment is not recorded.
- You can have someone with you if you require assistance.

Do you qualify?

Virtual appointments are available if you:

- have a <u>permanent photograph and signature</u> <u>exemption (Ontario.ca/RenewHealthCard)</u>,or
- are 18 years of age or older and have a valid photo health card that does not require a new photo/signature and is not expired

I don't qualify for a virtual appointment – how can I renew my Ontario Health Card?

If you do not qualify for a virtual appointment, there are a number of ways you can still renew your health card:

- **1.** renew online through ServiceOntario at Ontario.ca/RenewHealthCard (with an Ontario Photo Card or driver's licence)
- **2.** schedule an appointment at a participating ServiceOntario centre Ontario.ca/Appointment.
- 3. renew in person at any <u>ServiceOntario centre</u>.
- **4.** renew by mail (Seniors over 80, and children under 15 ½)
